Purpose: The **Intermediate FHM** course promotes integration of knowledge and skills essential to nursing assessment, promotion, and evaluation of fetal safety during labor.

Audience: The AWHONN Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course is designed for registered nurses, nurse midwives, and physicians who have completed a basic or foundations of FHM course and who use fetal heart monitoring technology in the intrapartum perinatal setting.

Prerequisites: Complete online content 32 hours before the start of class. If the online program is not completed, you will not be allowed to take the live session. Online content will be available 30 days before the start of class.

Objectives:

- 1. Assess EFM tracings utilizing NICHD terminology.
- 2. Interpret EFM tracings, analyze uterine activity, and discuss contractions' impact on fetal oxygenation.
- 3. Describe clinical interventions and the related maternal-fetal physiology.
- 4. Effectively communicate patient data through verbal and documentation methods.
- 5. Describe roles and responsibilities of health care providers when using FHM in intrapartum care.
- 6. Demonstrate selected fetal monitoring skills.

Post-Course Online Test

Within 30 days of the end of the course, complete the mandatory test and evaluation. Participant can begin online process after instructor updates in person "pass" in the online system.
