



AWHONN Advanced Fetal Monitoring Course

The Advanced Fetal Monitoring course expands on the knowledge and physiological principles presented in the AWHONN Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course. This course uses a case scenario approach to focus on the analysis of maternal-fetal physiology related to complex clinical information and fetal heart rate tracings. The course emphasizes the physiology of fetal-maternal oxygenation, the interpretation of tracings, the selection of clinical interventions, and perinatal risk-management principles. There is a recommended renewal date every two years for the Advanced Fetal Monitoring Course.

Learning Outcomes:

- 1) Describe the physiologic principals of the pregnant patient's and fetus's oxygen transfer as they apply to fetal heart monitoring.
- 2) Appraise the fetal response to the pregnant patient's pathological and physiological adaptations during the labor process.

Course Format:

Nursing contact hours/CME credit will be awarded after the successful completion of the online knowledge validation test and evaluation is completed and is required to receive nursing contact hours/CME credit for the course.
