Purpose or Objectives: At the conclusion of this activity, the participant will be able to:

1 Identify critically ill pediatric patients with unusual pathophysiology/diagnoses for which it would be appropriate to seek expert consultation and search the current literature to determine the best approach to diagnosis and management

- 2 Analyze contributing factors to patient adverse events using standard structural procedures.
- 3 Identify systems-based interventions to prevent future error based on isolated contributing factors.
