

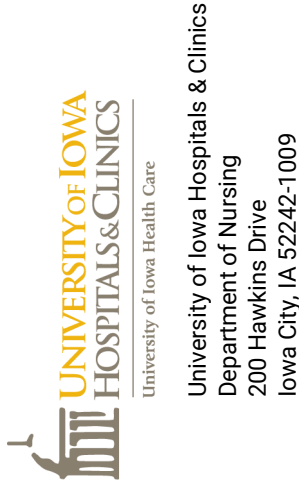

Educational Objectives

- Discuss treatment options for alcohol use disorder, starting in the hospital and extending into the outpatient setting.
- Discuss the role of antipsychotics in the prevention and treatment of delirium.
