

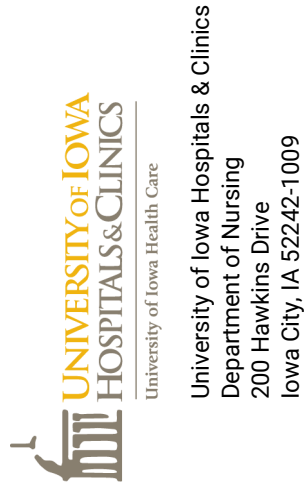

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Educational Objectives

Upon completion of this program, learner should be able to:

- Explain the proper trach care and maintenance of artificial airways.
- Describe current evidence based interventions to prevent and treat delirium.
- Describe risk factors for delayed and impaired wound healing. Discuss the management of challenging wound/skin/ostomy situations seen in oncology patients.
- Differentiate alcohol withdrawal from other withdrawal symptoms. Identify signs and symptoms of a severe alcohol withdrawal syndrome.
- Describe techniques aimed at preventing emotional and behavioral escalation of people in a workplace or educational setting. Discuss how to respond to escalated individuals.
