INTENDED AUDIENCE

Academic and community-based radiologists, radiology resident physicians, fellows, and radiology technologists.

PURPOSE

Current practices in Breast imaging and diagnostic radiology are continuing to change with new paradigms in screening and detection of breast pathology. Radiologists and their patients can benefit from knowledge-based and structural improvements to their practice. The Iowa Radiologic Society conference will explore these topics with local and national experts in their fields.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES
