OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this program the learner should be able to:

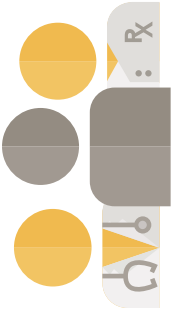
