IDENTIFY the diverse manifestations of sarcoidosis.

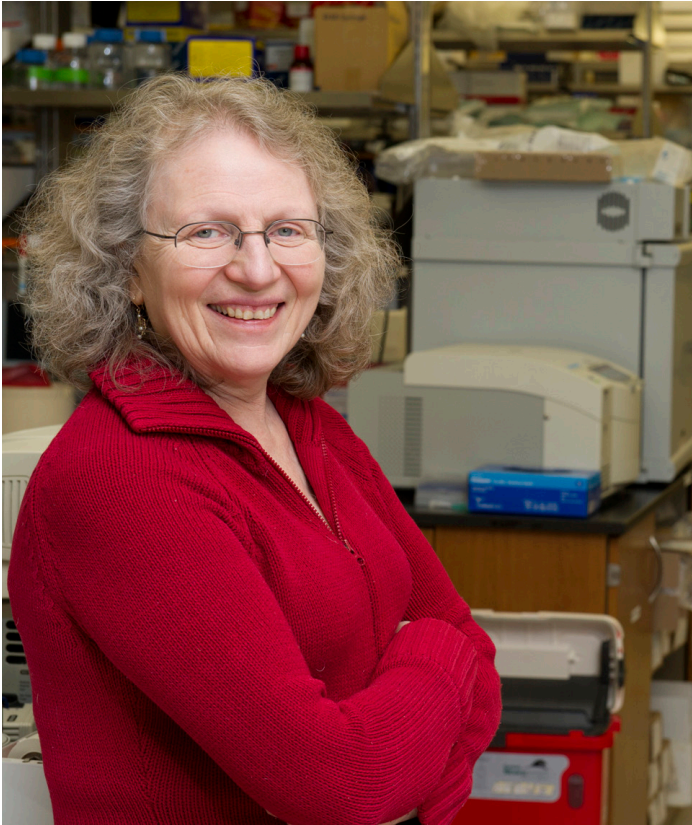
