# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Purpose:** This conference is designed to help surgeons increase their medical knowledge and practice performance regarding surgical care.

**Intended Audience:** The intended audience for this conference includes general surgeons, surgical residents, and medical students. Surgeons of other subspecialties, primary care physicians, physician-extenders and nurses may also find the content of the conference very useful.

**Educational Objectives:** Upon completion of this conference, the learner should be able to:

- Describe medical management of diverticulitis, segmental colitis associated with diverticulitis, and indications for surgery
- Discuss surgical management of esophageal cancer, melanoma, and peritoneal surface malignancies
- Describe medical versus surgical management of appendicitis in pediatric and adult populations
